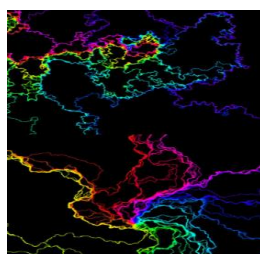
### NeX's Day Seminar
